Forms and Documents

Zoning Maps - are maintained from submitted site plans as re-zonings are approved by the Cherokee County Board of Commissioners. These maps have tax map and parcel information with the appropriate zoning designations overlaid. Also city boundaries are updated on these maps from annexation information received from cities.

2. Click “I want to...” and select “Address Search.”

5. Next, click on “Landmark Plat Link.”

6. Once the district (section) appears with the plat (lot), click to print or zoom. If you need to zoom, click the “Zoom” button and drag your mouse over the area you need to enlarge. After you enlarge that section, you may need to click and drag your mouse to reposition the map to keep the lot in view before printing the image.
